Topics discussed:

- Four resumes have been received to date for the Police Chief position. The deadline is Tuesday, June 30. The Board of Selectmen will decide by the 23rd if they need to expand the advertising.
- The Employee Compensation Committee is benchmarking compensation packages in NH towns of similar size. At this time, the committee isn't planning on looking at where volunteers fit in in terms of compensation and raises. The SB doesn't plan on changing the rates at this time.
- Clarence Meyers was heading up the regular workplace safety meetings. We don't expect the new Emergency Management Director to handle this responsibility.
- The current Ambulance Services and Fire Department members don't want a combined department. There might be an advantage to having an organization chart combining the two teams when applying for grants, but allowing the two teams to operate independently.
- Anton (Captain of Ambulance Services) is leaving at the end of the month. Lewis will be the acting Captain.
- We reviewed the first draft of the Emergency Management Director position and made suggestions for changes.
- Training for the first level of Emergency Responder certification will be offered in Langdon for five Sundays starting in November.
- This committee will focus on the Fire Department next, since Ambulance Services is in a state of transition.
- We should plan to attend the next Fire Department meeting on July 13.
